

## National One Church One Child In-Take Procedures

When an entity is interested in joining National One Church One Child (NOCOC) the following procedures should be followed:

Download from NOCOC website (<u>NationalOCOC.org</u>) and complete application form that is most appropriate for the applying entity:

<u>Collaborative Associate Program</u> is an agency, organization, etc who supports the concept of One Church, One Child but does not meet the criteria of an OCOC Program Member

An <u>official OCOC Member Program</u> is the traditional African American recruitment program, (primarily governed by a board of directors consisting of African-American Clergy), having the primary mission of educating, recruiting, and advocating for African American families to foster and/or adopt our children who are in the states' child welfare systems. This Program may also provide other services in addition to this <u>primary service</u> of African American recruitment

Submit the completed application and payment (if appropriate) to the National OCOC Intake Office, Florida: 111 North Gadsden Street, Suite 200, Tallahassee, Florida 32301

The Intake Office will notify the Steering Committee of the new member application

The Intake Office will process the application and send official notification of acceptance to the applying entity, along with a copy of the National bylaws

The National Administrative Office, Washington State, will add the new member to the NOCOC Membership List, the NOCOC website, and the NOCOC email list to be notified of any information distributed to the membership

The Intake Office will notify the total membership via e-mail of the new member
